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
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### JULY 03, 2021 | WEBINAR Cyclone Yaas: Living the impact

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



The informal chat session on studying Masters in Political Science and International Relations (IR) was a great opportunity for students interested in pursuing higher studies in these fields. The session aimed to

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
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



The talk was well-received by the audience. The speakers engaged the audience with their interactive presentation style and answered questions from the audience with great enthusiasm.







### 23 JANUARY, 2022 | SEMINAR The Nation of A Nation






### 28 FEBRUARY, 2022 | SEMINAR Science day Celebration


### 10 MARCH, 2022 | BOOK LAUNCH Gender Sensitisation Programme

The talk was delivered by Dr. Arnab Saha, Assistant Professor of Seth Anandaram Jaipuriya College, Kolkata.

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


### **APRIL 23, 2022** | SEMI-NAR




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## **10 - 17 MAY |** 7-DAY CERTIFICATE COURSE Value Education

On the 100-year anniversary of the birth of legendary filmmaker Satyajit Ray, Kiderpore College, in collaboration with New Alipore College, organized a seminar to honor the director's immense contributions



to Indian cinema. The seminar was attended by a panel of renowned speakers, including Prof. Sanjay Mukhopadhyay, Prof. Soumitra Basu, Dr. Abir Chattopadhyay, and Dr. Rajesh Das.

The seminar began with a brief overview of Satyajit Ray's life and career, courtesy of Prof. Mukhopadhyay. He explained how the director's films often commented on social issues like poverty and gender inequality, and how his unique approach to cinema changed the face of Indian film in the 20th century.
