GENERAL INSTRUCTION

The students have to submit **the <u>hand-written</u> projects** (maximum <u>15 pages</u>) only. Printed version will **not** be accepted. The project should be written on **A4** sheet preferably. If not available, use any white sheet. Every page must be margined properly. **No plastic channel files will be accepted**. Project must be stapled and the stapled pins are to be sealed with sticking tape properly before submission. The project work is expected to be neat and tidy. You may use any coloured pen **except red colour.**

The students are expected to divide the project into various sections mentioned below:

- **1.** Cover page with the project title, Student's name, <u>CU roll number</u> and <u>CU registration</u> number, Semester, Department (Hons or General)
- 2. Contents
- 3. Introduction
- 4. Aims and objectives
- 5. Location of study area
- **6.** Methods of data collection
- 7. Results & Discussion
- 8. Conclusion
- 9. Acknowledgement
- 10. References

The submitted projects must be concise.

N.B.: A sample project is uploaded as a guideline. Almost all the **text books** of Environmental Studies (mentioned in the subject classes already) have sample projects for guiding the students. Kindly consult them also.
