PROJECT TITLE(S)

Choose any one out of the seven project options given below:

1. Prepare a list of recyclable materials and habits which you use in your daily life to promote sustainable development.
2. Prepare a list of any disaster (natural or manmade) happened in India since the last 25 years and their effects on human health and surrounding environment.
3. Prepare a report on COVID-19/SARS-CoV2/Novel Corona virus outbreak in India and its effects on human health and surrounding environment.
4. Prepare a report on wetland, list of wetlands present in India and their importance in our daily life.
5. Prepare a report on strategies taken to clean the Ganga river (River Ganges) in India in last 25 years.
6. Prepare a report on Indian Sundarbans and their importance to mankind.
7. Prepare a report on the post-independence agricultural systems of India.

GENERAL INSTRUCTION

- The students have to submit **the hand-written projects** (maximum **12-15 pages**) only.
- Printed version will **not** be accepted. The project should be written on **A4** sheet preferably. If not available, use any white sheet.
- Every page must be margined properly.
- **No plastic channel files will be accepted.** Project must be stapled and the stapled pins are to be sealed with sticking tape properly before submission.
- The project work is expected to be neat and tidy.
- You may use any coloured pen **except red colour**.
- Either you can **paste your own clicked photographs** or **image source** will be properly mentioned if pictures are taken from the internet.
- After writing the whole project, scanned it (Camscanner allowed) and make a pdf. Upload the pdf in this google form (<https://forms.gle/xvYhFuURoubRJZcj6>), within 30th June.
- Due to COVID-19 outbreak, every students should do their project report staying/within in their house premises.
- The submitted project must be concise.

The students are expected to divide the project into **various sections** mentioned below:
