- Either you can **paste your own clicked photographs** or **image source** will be properly mentioned if pictures are taken from the internet.
- After writing the whole project, scanned it (Camscanner allowed) and make a pdf.

- Due to COVID-19 outbreak, every students should do their project report staying/within in their house premises.
- The submitted project must be concise.
