Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

this Memorandum of Understanding (NIoU) is entered into at SANSKRIF COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY on 25th February, 2014 between THE SANSKRIT COLLEGE AND UNIVERSITY and NEW ALIPORE COLLEGE, and NEW ALIPORE COLLEGE, and the NOLKATA-700053 agree that it would be mutually beneficial for both the Departments for research collaboration and faculty improvement programmes and other acasteric societies. Further the areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, and desirable and feasible activities keeping in view the soals

and objectives of each Department. Such interaction may include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and educational activities such as:

- 1. Exchange of resources
- 2. Explorations in knowledge data base
- 3. Joint hosting of seminars/events on special and rare collections
- 4. The collaborative process to create a sharable digital repository.
- 5. Collaboration with academics from both the institutes.
- 6. Exchange of students for studies with access to library resources.

The parties anticipate that a number of these initiatives will occur during the period of this MoU. However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is this MoU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

This MoU shall be identified as the parent document of any programme agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any programme shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing, executed by the duly authorized representatives of the both parties.

For agreed upon activities, both departments will make available their facilities and staff. This MoU will take effect on and from the date noted in the first line of this document and will be valid for five (5) years unless terminated by one of the parties subject to no financial or any other pending issue/matter between the parties. Either party may withdraw from this MoU provided written notification of the withdrawal is given to the other party at least six months prior to the desired withdrawal date. This MoU may be renewed for another period of five (5) years upon mutual written consent of the parties before the expiration date. Each department will have copies of this agreement.

This MoU serves only as a record of the parties' intentions and understandings and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process in any court of law and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied and this MoU is not legally enforceable in any court of law in India and abroad. Specific programmes and events will be discussed separately and formalized under the broad terms of the MoU agreed between both the parties.

This MoU will respect Intellectual Property Rights and any intellectual matter developed by the collaborative efforts of two departments, shall be retained by them. Both the parties shall respect and retain confidentially in each / any of the collaborative efforts, and all collaborative academic exercises shall be guided, directed and impelled by the greater academic interest of both the parties, and not any other /commercial interest.

This MoU shall not impose any additional financial burden for the Institutions to be borne by the Department of Higher Education of Government of West Bengal, although specific financial sanctions may be applied by the parties jointly for due consideration by the Department.
