This document establishes the guiding terms and principles of collaboration among the two organizations.

#### I. Framework of Both Organizations

NEW ALIPORE COLLEGE, KOLKATA, University of Calcutta (CU) affiliated, UGC recognized, NAAC accredited (with Grade 'A') and Government of West Bengal aided college situated at Block L, New Alipore, P.O. - New Alipore, Kolkata -700053, India, represented by the Principal, Dr. Jaydeep Sarangi referred to as First Party (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns) of one part.

### **AND**

The SCIENCE ASSOCIATION OF BENGAL, 104, Diamond Harbour Road, Kolkata -700008, India, represented by Professor Dr. SubhabrataRoychaudhurireferred to as Second Party and represented herein by its Zonal / Divisional Head, Director / Owner / Proprietor, (which term or expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to mean and include its in office, representatives, administrators, and assigns) of the other part.

#### Purpose of the Agreement II.

Both parties are pleased to enter upon an agreement to establish ties of academic cooperation in order to contribute to the achievement of their overall goals as institutions through following but not limited to

- 1. Joint Educational Research
- 2. Community Employment Activities
- 3. Exchange of Academic Materials
- 4. Approaches to Appropriate Government and Non-Government bodies for funding
- 5. Visits and formal exchanges of scholars, students and administrators in the specific areas of education, research and outreach
- 6. Organizing and co-hosting conferences, extension lectures, seminars, workshops, student internship, joint projects
- 7. Social and cultural programs
- 8. Students and staff exchange programs including visits, training and field trips
- 9. Provide support in the quality improvement of its partner institution by providing an independent audit of its infrastructure and teaching / learning environment
- 10. Educational / Vocational courses
- 11. Joint consultancy
- 12. Scientific publications
- 13. Any other activities that are mutually agreed upon and are beneficial to both
- 14. Faculty Development program

### **Executive of the Agreement** III.

The specific activities to be carried out under this agreement will be stated in the corresponding specific sub-agreements. Such specific sub-agreements, once approved by all the parties, will be attached as annexture to this agreement. The specific sub-agreements among all the parties will specify their objectives, conditions and ways of execution, financial support, the period the sub-agreements will be in effect, and administrative responsibility within each institution.

# IV. Term and Expiration of the Agreement

It is understood that this agreement will come into effect after being signed by the two parties and will be established for a period of five years. After these five years, it will be automatically extended for same period, unless one of the parties expresses an intention (by written notification) to cancel the agreement at last 90 days before the expiry date. The amendment, termination and expiration of this MOU will not affect the terms of activities ongoing at the time of notification of amendment, termination, or expiration unless otherwise agreed upon among the parties.

Any additions, changes, or deletions to this document must be approved by the representatives of both parties. All notices shall be in writing and shall be directed to these representatives.

## V. Non-Exclusivity

This agreement is a non-exclusive agreement and both parties remain free to enter into similar agreements with other parties.

# VI. Special Provisions

- 1. Each party will take approval from the other party in writing prior to using the latter's name and logo for the activities hereunder on a case-by-case basis.
- 2. Both parties hereto shall do their utmost to ensure the smooth and efficient implementation of the programs
- 3. Both parties will consult with each other for any subsequent associated agreement informally and attempt to resolve disputes or misunderstandings that may arise in the administration of the MOU or any subsequent associated agreement informally
- 4. Neither party can misuse this MOU by involving the name of the other without the written consent from the other parties.

### VII. Disputes

If any dispute airs in respect to the MOU, in that case both the organizations wildscuss and settle the matter amicably.
